Christmas in Action Light Up the Town Contest

Rules of the Contest

- 1. Contest is open to all homes in Wichita County TX. Only private residences are permitted, no commercial buildings or displays allowed.
- 2. Entrants will have their outdoor Christmas lighting displays judged and voted on by the public. Entrants receiving the three highest vote totals in each category will receive prizes. Ties will be broken by Christmas in Action. The winner of each category will also receive an award suitable for placement within their Christmas display.
- 3. Entry into the contest requires a \$25.00 donation. Only one entry per address.
- 4. The contest will run from Thanksgiving Day until Dec. 23rd.
- 5. Entrants must provide all required information on the Entry Form and submit the donation before their entry is considered complete. Entries must be received by 5:00 PM, Dec. 17th.
- 6. Entrants will choose one of four categories for their display to be judged in:
 - a. Classic: This is a simple design meant to remind of us of the classic Christmas' of yesteryear.
 - b. Clark Griswold: Homes that are over-the-top and may require its own power station.
 - c. Martha Stewart: An elegant design that could be found on the cover of *Living* Magazine.
 - d. Rock the Block: A display that is set to music and/or animated. Christmas in Action is not responsible for traffic jams or angry neighbors.
- 7. Displays may be created/constructed by professionals or non-professionals. Entrants are not required to create/construct the display. All materials and power required for the display are the responsibility of the entrant.
- 8. Displays must remain within the confines of the property identified in the entry form.
- 9. Entrants are responsible to ensure their display complies with all applicable laws, ordinances and local code requirements.
- 10. Displays are encouraged to be lit until at least 10:00 pm each night. There is no limit on how long the displays may be lit.
- 11. Entrants will be provided a sign with a unique QR code that will allow the public to vote for each display. Christmas in Action will collect the signs at the end of the contest no later than 1 Jan. Entrants are responsible for the placement and lighting of the sign. They may place, light and decorate the sign however they wish, but it is recommended to place it as close to the street as possible and keep the QR code clear and well lit.
- 12. Voting may also be done online at christmasinactionwftx.org. Entrants are encouraged to submit a photograph of their display for inclusion on the website. The entrants name will NOT be associated with the address on the website or voting forms.
- 13. A Gmail account is required to vote. Only 1 vote per Gmail account per display.
- 14. Christmas in Action will announce the winners on their website on Dec. 24th and prizes will be available the first business day after Dec. 25th. First place winners will have the award delivered to their display on Dec. 24th, in time for inclusion into the display that night. Winning entrants must agree to have their names and likeness published by Christmas in Action before claiming any prize.
